I. SIU Training

- Delphine Billy informed the Coalition of the SIU Training she attended this past month. Letting them know that since our last SIU agent retired, law enforcement is restarting patrols. Once there is an assigned SIU agent, we will request data for past quarters to share. Party patrols will begin to see if adults are providing to minors.

II. ATOD

- Delphine attended the Wingate School Board meeting in an effort to receive more ATOD numbers. Wingate has not reopened their dormitories and are still doing hybrid schooling. GMCS is having students participate in internships in the community. The school district may be looking into the community for internship opportunities for the students.

III. Prevention Activities & Presentations

- Presentations at Central High School. Students were attentive but Delphine will be modifying the presentation to draw them in. Will be doing Botvin training for high school aged youth as a primary focus.
- Kelly recommended that we reach out to Wingate High School Dormitory for presentations online. She does virtual presentations twice a month. She will pass along our information to the Dorm Supervisor.

VII. Resources

- Byrickson Henderson is facilitating a father's group/ talking circle, twice a month, one morning session and one afternoon session.
- Summer with NMSAS mentioned that April is Sexual Assault Awareness month. Her agency is planning a number of events in April. On April 2nd, they are collaborating with Rio West Mall to host a Clothing Closet. They will have a table there and T-Shirts sharing messages. On April 11th, they are holding the 1st Annual First Responders Breakfast and raffle at their downtown office. On April 21st, they will have an event called "Take Back the Night". They will meet at their downtown office about 5:30 p.m. and will march to the Court House Square. There will be speakers and a candlelight vigil. It will be open to the public and any other agencies who would like to participate. They are also working with the City of Gallup to host a Free Movie Night at El Morro Theatre. They will be showing "The Shack." It will most likely be on a Friday evening or weekend. Once the flyers are finalized, she will send them out.
